Procedure for Public Comments

DHC has two public comment periods. The first is limited to comments on Agenda Action Items. The General Public Comments is near the end of the agenda. Members of the public who attend virtually will be able to sign up for both public comment on the agenda and for General Public Comment by raising their hand and identifying themselves within the Zoom app during public comment. All other persons may sign up for public comment at the meeting if they are able to appear in the meeting room, provided there is sufficient space to accommodate those who wish to attend in person. When it is the speaker's turn to address the Board, the Board President will identify the person. When the speaker's name is called, the speaker's phone will be unmuted. Once the speaker's time is up, the

phone will be muted. Speakers will be limited to 3 minutes. Group representatives will be limited to 5 minutes.

Unmute  / **Mute**  : You can click/tap on Mic icon on the zoom app to unmute and talk if you would like to speak during the board meeting public comments session. You will receive a notification from the meeting host to unmute your Mic.

Raise Hand  : Raise your hand to indicate that you have a question/comment and would like to speak during the meeting public comments session.
