Procedure for Public Comments

DHC has two public comment periods. The first is limited to comments on Agenda Action Items. The other is for General Public Comments near the end of the Agenda. In order for members of the public to speak during the public comment periods, members of the public must sign up no later than 9:00 a.m. the day of the meeting by doing the following:

1. Call 313-202-0815
2. Leave a voice mail message with this information:
 - a. Name and spelling of name.
 - b. Telephone number which will be used to call in to the meeting. The telephone number will be used to identify persons who have signed up to speak during public comment.
 - c. Whether the speaker wants to address the Board during Public Comments on Agenda Action Items or General Public Comments.
 - d. If the speaker represents a group, state and spell the name of the group.

Members of the public who attend virtually will be able to sign up for both public comment on the Agenda and for General Public Comment by calling the number specified above and/or by raising your hand and identifying yourself within the Zoom app during public comment. All other persons may sign up in the meeting if they are able to appear in the meeting room, provided there is sufficient space to accommodate those who care to make a physical appearance. Though it is not required that persons who would like to speak at the designated times call the number listed above, it is requested where possible, to call in for a place on the agenda to help with the administration of the public comment process.

Unmute  / **Mute**  : You can click/tap on Mic icon on the zoom app to unmute and talk if you would like to speak during the board meeting public comments session. You will receive a notification from the meeting host to unmute your Mic.

Raise Hand  : Raise your hand to indicate that you have a question/comment and would like to speak during the meeting public comments session.

When it is the speaker's turn to address the Board, the Board President will identify the person.

When the speaker's name is called, the speaker's phone will be unmuted. Once the speaker's time is up, the phone will be muted.

Speakers will be limited to 3 minutes. Group representatives will be limited to 5 minutes.
